I. The Reality of God's Wrath (v. 18-19)

A. The origination of God's Wrath (v. 18a)

"For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven..." - v. 18a

- 1. It is from the heaven
- 2. It is justice for enmity with God
- B. The focus of God's wrath (v. 18b)

"..against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness.." – v. 18b

- 1. Ungodliness disregard for God
- 2. Unrighteousness- the result of a disregard of God
- C. The revelation of God's wrath (v. 19)
 - 1. God's divine wrath is seen in scripture
 - The Flood Gen. 6-8
 - Sodom & Gomorrah Gen. 19
 - The Plagues and Red Sea judgment on Egypt Ex. 7-14
 - 2. God's wrath is seen in the "sowing & reaping" principle Gal. 6:9

II. The Reality of God's Grace and Man's Lack of Excuse (v. 20-23)

- A. By His grace God reveals Himself to all Men (v. 20a)
 - 1. Through nature (Ps. 19:1-9)
 - 2. Through the sustaining of nature

"And He is before all things and in Him all things consist" - Col. 1:17

- B. By man's rejection hearts are hardened (v. 21)
 - 1. There is a point of no return (Gen. 6:3, II Cor. 4:3-4)
 - 2. There is a point when God will cease to reveal Himself

"..but became futile in their thoughts..." - v. 21

- C. Man's hardness leads to idolatry (v. 22-23)
 - 1. There is the misconception of their wisdom
 - 2. There is the misdirection of their worship

III. The Reality of God's Abandonment (v. 24-32)

- A. God will abandon man to a reprobate heart (v. 24-25)
 - 1. The heart that is tainted by sin
 - 2. The heart that is naturally wicked

"The heart is deceitful above all things and desperately wicked; Who can know it?" - Jer. 17:9

- B. God will abandon man to reprobate actions (v. 26-27)
- C. God will abandon man to a reprobate mind (v. 28-32)
 - 1. A mind that forgets God
 - 2. A mind that drives one to unrighteousness
 - 3. A mind that takes one into eternal judgment.
