I. The Reason for God's Judgment is Revealed (v. 1-5)

- A. The sinfulness of the hypocrite (v. 1)
 - 1. They assume the place of God in judgment
 - 2. They may be as guilty as the person they are judging
- B. The righteous sentence on the hypocrite (v. 2-3)
 - 1. We realize the purity of the Judge (v. 2)
 - He is sovereign in His judgment
 - He searches the heart in His judgement (1 Samuel 16:7)
 - 2. The power of the evidence (v. 3)
 - The evidence may not appear outwardly to man
 - The hypocritical judge will be condemned for their wicked heart

- A. The judgment of God is very personal in nature (v. 6)
 - 1. Our lives are laid bare before God (Hebrews 4:13; Jeremiah 17:10)
 - 2. You will not pay for the sins of others in final judgment
- B. The judgement of God is proper (v. 7-10)
 - 1. The fruit of the righteous will be revealed (v. 7, 10)
 - 2. The guilt of the unrighteous exposed (v. 8-9)
- C. The judgement of God is perfect (v. 11)
 - 1. God is impartial
 - 2. God does not give a pass on the unredeemed that seem to be good
 - 3. God will hold the evil, wicked accountable

III. The Realization of God's Judgment on the Unrighteous (v. 12-16)

- A. Judgment is due to rebellion (v. 12)
 - 1. Ultimately judgment falls for rebellion against God's law
 - 2. It is sin that ultimately brings the wrath God (Ezekiel 18:4; 20)
